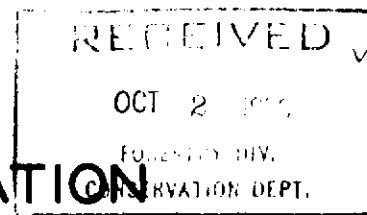

DESCRIPTION IN DETAIL AS TO HOW CORNER WAS LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED OR RESTORED.

Corner was found, and later shown to me, by Mr. Harold Cole, Engineer and Cruiser for Northwestern Veneer and Plywood Corp., who are logging a large area in this township.

One original B.T. still visible, and in fairly good condition. Because this corner fell in a road, we were unable to place our regular corner marker. We placed a 10" spike, 6" below the road surface.

Corner was placed and witnessed September 14, 1950.
