1936: The comer is indicated as a Pin on the Map of Lake Independence and Vicinity drawn by H.E. McKenzie for the Brunswick Lumber Company, recorded as Map #93 of Miscellaneous Maps at the Marquette County Courthouse. No accessories given.

1936: Survey notes by Heilala from the MCRC F.B. #239, pp. 88-89, indicates they dug up an Old Iron Pin set for the corner in road about 4" below surface and about 4' West of C/L Co. Rd. 550. Corner was 22' South of a fence line running West, 32' North of a fence line running West, and 22' North of the C/L of a road running West.
