

PERPETUATION: George B. Wilson (RLS 17607) in Jan. 1981 - Certified Survey No. 204 shows a subdivision of Section 8, T32N-R27W, indicating the location of Corner C-4. LCRC No. 722, Book 3 recorded by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461, based on information in Certified Survey No. 204.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 5/8" dia. Iron Rod/identification cap (MI 26461/WII1569) in location matching information contained in Certified Survey No. 204. There is about an 8° deflection in the county road at this location, and the corner falls at the PI of the centerlines running North and South from this position. There is also an old lane running East and an old fence line running West from this location. This corner has been used for control in surveys in this area, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the location of the original corner.
