

Found a broken Berntsen Monument (W1B) set by George B. Wilson as indicated in LCRC 207 and in Certified Survey No. 204 as referenced above. This corner falls in the centerline of County Road No. 577, in line with the centerline of Elmwood Road running East from this location and in line with an old fence line running West from this location.
