Original Survey by James H. Mullett in 1848. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.

PERPETUATION: Certified Survey No. 269 by George B. Wilson (RLS No. 17607) shows the location of this corner as it relates to other corners in section 16.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner;

Found Berntsen W1C 30" long monument/4" diameter aluminum cap (sheared off by snowplow). This corner was found in the location indicated by information contained in Certified Survey No. 269. This corner is also shown in an unrecorded survey map dated 1/12/74 by George B. Wilson, indicating that the corner position was established in the centerline of an East -West county road and placed 2.2 chains (Original Field Notes) from a swamp edge. This position has been used in several surveys over the past 20 years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Set 5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner in Monument Box:
