B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 3/4" dia. Aluminum Rod $/3\frac{1}{4}$ " dia. Aluminum cap next to remains of old squared wood post. The corner is at the intersection of very old fences which run East and South from this position. The corner monument was set by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, and was recorded in Book 2 of Land Corner Records on page 374. This corner has been used for control in several surveys, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
