



A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

ORIGINAL B.T.'s:

Cedar, 8", $N35\frac{1}{2}$ °E, 11 1ks Cedar, 12", S71°E, 12 1ks

Original Survey by James H. Mullett in 1848. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found Berntsen Monument (sheared off by snow plow) set by William Lenca in 1981. The corner was placed in the centerline of Twin Creek Road (East-West) and in line with an old fence line running North from this position. This location fits well with 1/16 fence to the West. This corner has been used for several surveys over the past 12 years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

Corner was previously recorded in Book 2 of Land Corner Records on page 533.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Aluminum cap stamped for corner, in Monument Box:
