Original Survey by James H. Mullett in 1848. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a "T" iron set by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, in a 1974 survey. Wilson's records indicate that he found a 15" long flat steel plate 8" below pavement, along side a wood post. The corner position falls in the centerline of County Road 571 (North-South) and 6' North of an old fence East, as noted in Robert Olsen's 1966 survey of this area. This corner position has been used for control in several surveys, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner of 10^{-1} Mich. Set 5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/ $3\frac{1}{4}$ " dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner:
