Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Survey by John Mullett - B.T.'s - Spruce, 4"- N46°E- 13 lks; Spruce, 14" - N14°W - 05 lks. No original evidence found.

A.L. Hillis made a survey of this area and used this corner. He describes it only as "stake" and gives no B.T.'s. 1896:

1974: L.C.R.C. No. 74 by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607 - states that he found a very old 3" square wood stake in good condition below water line. He states that from the condition of the stake, he believes it could be 75 years old. He set a 4" dia, concrete monument with 1/2" iron rod encased and the following B.T.'s - 4" Tam. - N350E - 15.2", 5" Tam. - N220W -18.0': 5" Tam. - S05°E - 13.9'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We found a 4" diameter concrete monument and the 3 B.T.'s described in L.C.R.C. No. 74. This position has been accepted as the corner for almost 100 years. We therefore accepted the concrete monument as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
