- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - Original Survey by John Mullett B.T.'s Cedar, 10", N21°E, 13 lks & Cedar, 12", S78°W, 18 lks. No evidence of the original corner or its accessories was found.
 - L.C.R.C. No. 166 recorded by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, states that a 4 inch square concrete monument was set 1977: based on remnants of old fences as the best available evidence. No. B.T.'s are given.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

A 4 inch square concrete monument as described in L.C.R.C. No. 166 (mentioned in part "A"). This corner location falls 28 feet South of the centerline of an East - West County Road. This corner has been used for survey contol over the past 17 years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
