A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1848: Original Survey by John Mullett - B.T.'s - Black Ash, 8" - S81°E - 12 lks; Black Ash, 6" - S23°W - 07 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We recovered a "Deep - 1" magnet in the centerline of a North - South County Road and in line with the extension West of a very old fence line East of this location. The distance from the corner position East to the 1/16 corner, as fenced, is 1373 feet. The distance from the corner position East to the Section Corner is 2749 feet. The corner position fits well with existing lines of occupation, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/3-1/4" dia. Aluminum cap stamped for corner location:
