All original evidence has been destroyed by county road improvements. Record of Survey by Albert Haas, County Surveyor, shows partial subdivision of Section 12 and shows the location of corner M-5 as it relates to other corners in Section 12. Haas' record states that "corner formerly set". No monument is described and no new ties are given. L.C.R.C. No. 596 by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, states that a Deep-1 Magnet was set using A. Haas Survey and Road centerlines. TIES: Deep-1 - NE - 36.5 feet; Deep-1 - SE - 47.3 feet. 	
B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:	
We recovered a W-1-B Bertsen Monument with a 4 inch diameter cap in the centerline of county roads running North - South and West. This monument is typical of those set by George B. Wilson in the late 1970's and early 1980's, and was apparently set to replace the Deep-1 magnet described in part "A". Our measured distance North to the E1/4 Corner of Section 12 is 2564.44 feet as compared to Albert Haas' recorded distance of 2568.7 feet. Our measured distance West to the S1/4 Corner of Section 12 is 2638.88 feet as compared to Albert Haas' recorded distance of 2645.3 feet. We accepted the position of the W-1-B Berntsen Monument as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
