

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Survey by John Mullett - B.T.'s - Cedar, 12" - N46°W - 13 lks.; Fir, 4" - S45.5°W - 16 lks. All original evidence 1848: for this corner has been destroyed by logging and road improvements.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We set this corner in the centerline of an old lane running East - West and in line with an ancient fence line running South from this position. This location fits with a 2 inch diameter Iron Pipe found at the W1/16 corner on the south line of Section 18, T34N -R25W. This location also fits within 3 feet of a GLO terrain call to a stream 478.5' West, and matches closely with a single proportional location, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
