NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

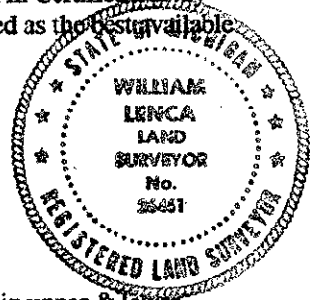

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

- 1848: Original Survey by John Mullett - B.T.'s - Cedar, 10" - S29°E - 12 lks.; Cedar, 10" - S66°W - 19 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.
- 1980: Certified Survey No. 184 by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, shows this corner as it relates to other corners in Section 20, T34N-R25W. The corner monument is not described, and no B.T.'s are given.
- 1982: L.C.R.C. No. 545 by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461, states: "Found corner in location indicated by existing county roads north - south and east - west. Found 3/4" Iron Pipe 16" below East edge of blacktop surface County Road." TIES: Telephone Pole - N30°E - 22.23'; Telephone Pole - S28°E - 121.36'; Telephone Pole - S72°W - 67.42'; Telephone Pole - N27°W - 86.43'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We recovered a 3/4 inch diameter Iron Pipe in a location as described in Land Corner Recordation Certificate Number 545. The corner falls in line with an old lane to the East and the centerline of a county road to the West, and on the East edge of the asphalt surface of a North - South County Road. The distance from this corner East to the 1/4 Corner between Sections 17 and 20 fits with the distance shown in Certified Survey No. 184 as 2616.90 feet. This distance is also shown on the old Highway Plans for M-35 as 2616.80 feet. The distance South to the 1/4 Corner between Sections 17 and 18 also matches with that shown in Certified Survey No. 184. This corner monument has been accepted and used by local surveyors for many years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.



C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 2" dia. Aluminum Pipe 30" long/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location:
