A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: Original Survey by H. Floyd - B.T.'s - Elm, 6" - N850W - 19 lks.; Elm, 8" - S640W - 55 lks. All original evidence for this 1847: corner has been destroyed by county road improvements. 1895: Plat of Survey by Justus Little shows this corner in relation to other corners in Section 30, T34N - R26W. No monument is described and no witnesses are given. 1997: Plat of Survey by William Lenca shows this corner as it relates to other corners in Section 25, T34N-R27W, and states that a railroad spike was set. B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: We recovered a railroad spike 4.5' West of the centerline of a North - South county road. This corner was established in the centerline of county roads North, South, and East, but new construction has moved the North - South centerline 4.5' to the East. The corner falls in line with the centerline of a county road running East and fits with the 1/16 fence to the North.
