

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - Original Survey by Henry Floyd B.T.'s Sugar, 18" N250E 28 lks.; Sugar, 26" N400W 10 lks. All original evidence 1847: for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.
 - L.C.R.C. Number 891 by William Lenca states, "Set corner in line with centerline of County Roads E-W and N." Set 1989: Railroad Spike, TIES: S.W. Corner of Stone Barn - N38°E - 50.30'; Power Pole - S69°E - 74.84'; Power Pole - S69°W -45.43'; Power Pole - N27°W - 61.66'.
 - Plat of Survey by William Lenca shows this corner in relation to other corners in Section 32, T35N R26W. 1989:
- Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We found a Railroad Spike in a location as described in Land Corner Recordation Certificate Number 891 by William Lenca. This location has been used for many years and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
