

 - Original Survey by James H. Mullett B.T.'s Tamarack, 6" S890E 17 lks.; Tamarack, 10" S210W 07 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by logging activities.
 - L.C.R.C. No. 911 by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461, states "set 3/4" x 60" Alum. rod / 3-1/2" cap marked "Menominee County Survey Marker" on line and midway between section corners. This position fits well with G.L.O. terrain call to swamp edge North." TIES: Carsonite - N16°E - 1.64', W. Ash, 9" - S35°E - 3.53', W. Ash, 6" - S41°W - 18.10', W. Ash, 9" - West - 21.60'; W. Ash, 8" - N450W - 20.00'.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

We found a 3/4 inch x 5 foot Aluminum rod with a 3-1/4" diameter Aluminum cap stamped for corner. We also found 4 existing B.T.'s and carsonite in place as described in L.C.R.C. No. 911 (seet part A). This corner is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
