Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: Original Survey by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - W. Pine, 4" - S06.50W - 11 iks.; Birch, 8" - S450E - 17 iks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by logging activities. 1900: Albert Hass's survey of Section 22 shows he set a 4" cedar post from Government B.T. No evidence of this corner was recovered due to logging activities. 1975: Plat of Survey by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, shows this corner in relation to other corners in the N1/2 of Section 22 - Wilson's distances match with those shown in Albert Hass Survey from 1900. Certified Survey Number 56 by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, shows this corner in relation to other corners in Section 1976: 15, T34N-R27W. B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: After computing the location of this corner based on Geroge Wilson's surveys in Section 15 and 22, we traversed in to it and searched the area but found no evidence of the original corner accessories, or evidence of subsequent restoration. This location matches well with a G.L.O. Terrain Call to the east. There is remnants of an old fence nailed to trees which is approximately 5 feet North of the corner position. This position fits very closely with Albert Hass' Survey, has been used by local surveyors for more than 20 years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
