B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

My Field Notes from a 1988 survey of Section 35, T35N-R27W state: Set P.K. in centerline of county road East and West and in line with an old fence to the South. TIES: Elm, 12" - N05°E - 107.10'; Power Pole - S79°E - 141.65'; Power Pole - S28°E - 33.02'. In our 1998 remonumentation survey, we found a P.K. nail in the centerline of an East - West county road and in line with old fences North - South. We also recovered the 3 witnesses described above. This position has been used in other surveys, fits existing lines of occupation, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
