

, 1999 do hereby state that under William Lenca Nov. in a field survey on requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - Twp. Boundary by H. Floyd B.T.'s Lynn, 10" 5680W 25 lks; Lynn, 36" 8470W -
 - Sectional Subdivision by James H. Mullett B.T.'s Sugar, 8" S46°E 13 lks.; Sugar, 12" N78°E 38 lks. All original 1848: evidence for this corner has been destroyed by land clearing and farming activities.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We set this corner at an ancient fence corner - fences run North - South and West from this position. This position fits well with the 1/16 fence line 1/4 mile South, is consitent with long standing lines of occupation and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 3/4" dia. x 4' long aluminum rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner.

38.05 feet Scr. NBT 20" dia. Elm North S 50 E 40.78 feet Scr. NBT 6" dia. Maple Scr. NBT West 1.75 feet. 24" dia. Elm Nothing else nearby Metal Survey Sign Post East 3.50 feet
