

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Twp. Boundary by H. Floyd - B.T.'s - Hemlock, 9" - S57°W - 12 lks; Cedar, 12" - N43°W - 34 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Finding no evidence of the original corner accessories, or evidence of subsequent restoration, we accepted a corner position falling in line with the centerline of County Roads running East - West and South and in line with the extension South of an ancient fence running North. This position fits reasonably well with measurements to corners 1/2 mile North (2663.25 feet) and 1/2 mile South (2685.59 feet), fits well with existing lines of occupation, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location in Monument Box;
