B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We set this corner in the centerline of an East - West county road and in line with an old fence to the South. This position makes the quarter corner to the West very nearly midway between section corners and fits closely with the GLO measurement to the 1/4 Corner 1/2 mile East, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
