

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Survey by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Hemlock, 12" - S63° W - 13 lks.; Maple, 12" - N75°E - 22 lks. All original 1848: evidence for this corner has been destroyed by County Road improvements.

L.C.R.C. No. 262, Book 1, by Gerald W. Carlson, RLS No. 24589 states "Fd. 1/2" x 1" Iron bar 8" below blktop road in 1980: centerline 4-way intersection." TIES: Power Pole - N48°W - 47.57'; Elm 24" - N19°E - 91.17'; Guy Pole - N58°E - 55.46'; Ash 10" - S150E - 79.28'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We found a 1/2 inch x 1 inch iron bar in the centerline with the centerline of county roads running North - South and East - West, along the the ties as described in L.C.R.C. No. 262, Book 1 (see part A). This position fits well with measurements to corners 1/2 mile North and 1/2 mile South, has been accepted and used by local surveyors for over 20 years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
