- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - 1848: Original Survey by James H. Mullett B.T.'s Tamarack, 6" N39°E 4 lks.; Cedar, 6" S33°W 5 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by County Road improvements.
 - 1976: L.C.R.C. No. 130, Book 1, by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607 states "County Road Commission dug hole 10' x 10' x 6' deep. Found mark of old stake in gray sand just below original top soil. Set Concrete Monument, 4" dia. x 36" long with 1/2" iron rod inside." NBT'S: Cedar 3", N40°E, 48.36'; Cedar 4", N76°E, 28.36'.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We recovered a 4 inch diameter concrete monument with 1/2 inch diameter iron pin in the center in location as described in L.C.R.C. No. 130, Book 1 (see part A). The corner falls in the centerline of county roads North - South - West and in line with an old fence running East. Wilson's record does not indicate if he verified the mark of the old stake as an original, so we accepted the position of the concrete monument as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
