

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - Original Survey by James H. Mullett B.T.'s Cedar 12", N49°E 14 lks.; Cedar 12", N64°W 14 lks.; Cedar 12" -S65°E - 17 lks.; Tamarack 10" - S5°W - 20 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by County Road improvements.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a Railroad Spike in the centerline of a county road intersection - county roads run East - West and North. This corner has been accepted and used by local surveyors for several years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the OF BIEHIE original corner.
