

requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law, established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
  - Original Survey by James H. Mullett B.T.'s Birch, 12" S70°W 24 lks.; Sugar, 35" N36°E 05 lks. All original 1848: evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.

- L.C.R.C. No. 118 by David Babbitt, RLS No. 21558, states "set 1/2" dai. pipe in c/l rd intersection could find no other 1975: evidence." B.T.'s: 8" Elm - N10°E - 151.3'; 3" Cedar - S42°W - 106.3'
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We recovered a 1/2 inch diameter iron pipe in the center of a 4 way county road intersection, along with 2 B.T.'s in location as described in L.C.R.C. No. 118 in part "A" above. This corner position fits well with existing lines of occupation, has been used by local surveyors for at least 24 years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
