- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restorate
 - Original Survey by James H. Mullett B.T.'s Becch, 6" S31°W 26 lks.; Beech, 4" N34°E 12 lks.; All original 1848:
 - evidence for this corner has been destroyed by County Road improvements. L.C.R.C. No. 121, Book 1, by David B. Babbitt, RLS No, 21558 states "No mon. found. Set 1" iron pipe with 4" aluminum cap at intersection of roads E-W-S and in line with old fence north as being the best evidence for the proper location of this 1975: corner." TIES: Elm 18", S20°W, 73.4"; Stop Sign, S26°E, 49.2'.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 1 inch diameter iron pipe with standard DNR 4 inch diameter aluminum cap stamped for corner location in place as described in L.C.R.C. No. 121 (see part A). The corner falls in the centerline of county roads running East - West and South, and in line with old fence line running North. This corner has been used by local surveyors for at least 25 years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
