- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

In our 1987 survey noted in part "A" above, we monumented this corner with a Railroad Spike. In our 1998 remonumentation survey, we recovered a railroad spike in the centerline of a North - South county road and in line with an old fence to the West, which fits with the position as shown in the 1987 survey. This corner position has been used in several surveys, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
