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

in a field survey on William Lenca Sep. 1999 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Survey by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Black Ash, 14" - N12°E - 25 lks; Tamarack, 15" - S43°E - 12 lks. All 1848: original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner was re-established on a straight line between the Northwest Corner and the Northeast Corner of Section 19, T35N-R27W, and at a location based on single proportion between these corners. The corner falls in the centerline of a North - South County Road, and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location:
