Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1848: Original Survey by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Cedar, 6" - \$110W - 05 lks; Cedar, 6" - N270W - 10 lks. No original evidence for this corner was recovered.

Description of corner evidence lound and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

In a February, 1995 survey of Section 10, T35N-R27W, we recovered the Northwest and the Northeast Section Corners, and found that the distance between them was 5379.44 feet. We set the quarter corner (H-3) midway and on line between the section corners. The corner position thus established fits well with existing lines of occupation and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner. Set 5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location:
