William Lonca in a field survey on May 08 19 95 in hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned tines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 hove were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

IOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1848: Original Survey by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Cedar, 6" - \$12°E - 17 lks; Cedar, 6" - N89°W - 05 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.

1979: Certified Survey No. 170 recorded by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, indicates in the legend that a 1/2" diameter iron pin was set. A bearing and distance of N01°21'33"W, 2689.28 feet is shown between this corner and the Section Corner to the North.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

In a April 1995 survey of Section 3, T35N-R27W, we recovered a 1/2" diameter iron pin in the centerline of a North - South County road and in line with an old lane running West and a fence running East. We found that the distance between this corner and the Section corner to the north measured 2689.22 feet, which matches closely with Wilson's distance of 2689.28 feet as recorded in Certified Survey No. 170. This corner position has been used consistently for several years by local surveyors, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner Sct 2" dia. Aluminum Pipc/3-1/4" dia. Alum cap stamped for corner location:
