William Lenca , 19 99 do hereby state that under in a field survey on Nov. requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

- 1848: Sectional Subdivision by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Sugar, 12" - N58°W - 24 lks.; Sugar, 15" - S45°E - 11 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.
- 1900: Subd. of Section 24, T35N-R27W by Albert Hass states "Corner formerly set, nothing near". Distances shown to other corners in Section 24.
- L.C.R.C. No. 890, Bk 3, by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461 Found 1/2" dia. Iron Rod set by George B. Wilson, RLS 17607, in center of E W Co. Rd and in line with ancient fences N S. TIES: 1/2" dia. Iron Rod $N54^{\circ}E$ 55.25° ; 1/2" 1990: dia. Iron Rod - S520E - 38.88'; Basswood, 10" - S570W - 27.15'; FN W-5298 Sign Post - N190W - 32.97'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We found a 1/2 inch diameter iron rod in the centerline of an East - West County Road and in line with ancient fences running North and South, along with the ties described in part "A" above. The distance from this corner to the 1/4 Corner to the East is 2651.30 feet compared to Alber Hass's record distance of 2650.56 feet. This corner position matches well with old surveys and long standing lines of occupation, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location in Monument Box:
