

  - 1987: Certified Survey No. 518, by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461, shows a tie to this corner.
- Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We recovered a railroad spike in the centerline of county roads running North - South and East, and in line with an ancient fence line running West. The position of this corner matches with the tie shown in Certified Survey No. 518, fits with existing lines of occupation, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
