- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
  - Original Survey by Francis Coleman B.T.'s Cedar, 6" N35°E 07 lks.; Spruce, 4" S54°W 05 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by logging activities.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We computed the single proportional location for this corner, traversed into it and searched the area. We found a 12 inch diameter Cedar Stub lying on the ground near this position, but could not positively identify it as an O.B.T. We dug in the area that the original post would have been based on this stub, but found no evidence. We therefore accepted the single proportional location as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 2" dia. Aluminum Pipe 30" long/3-1/4" dia. Alum cap stamped for corner location:
