

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
  - Original Survey by Francis Coleman B.T.'s Tamarack, 6" N06°W 34 lks.; Tamarack, 8" S18°E 44 lks. Long stub 1852: of original Tamarack B.T. (Tam, 6" - N06°W - 34 links) down and still in fair condition.
  - L.C.R.C. No. 48 by Billy D. Buckler states corner was replaced from 2 Tamarack B.T.'s bearing N08°W, 32 lks, stub in 1960: excellent condition and S18°E, 44 lks, stump in poor condition. Corner lies on north bank of stream. Set 1" Pipe with 4" Brass Cap.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We found 2 Cedar B.T.'s as described in LCRC No. 48, Volume 2 (see part "A" above), but were unable to recover the monument. The bank of the stream has eroded in this area and the action of the water and ice has destroyed the monument. The corner position was re-monumented from 2 Cedar B.T.'s as described in LCRC No. 48. The corner falls in the water on the North edge of a stream and on line with an old brush line running East and West. Since this corner was replaced from Original Bearing Trees, we accepted this location as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 3/4" dia. x 4' long aluminum rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner inside a 1-1/2" x 40" Iron Pipe.
