

Nov. , 19 99 do hereby state that under William Lenca in a field survey on requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.



A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Survey by Francis Coleman - B.T.'s - Hemlock, 16" - N64°W - 22 lks.; Cedar, 10" - S62°E - 34 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

In a retracement of the East Line of Section 34, T35N-R28W, we recovered a 1/2 inch diameter iron rod in the centerline of a North - South gravel surface County Road and in line with an old blazed line running to the East. Measurements to established corners 1/2 mile North (2633.58 feet) and 1 mile South (5262.87 feet) fit very well. We accepted the location of the existing 1/2 inch iron as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 2"dia. Aluminum Pipe 30" long/3-1/4" dia. Alum cap stamped for corner location:
