

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Survey by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Cedar, 8" - N220W - 15 lks.; Cedar, 8" - S050E - 15 lks. All original

evidence for this corner has been destroyed by logging activities.

L.C.R.C. No. 682 (Vol. 3) recorded by Frank J. Bray, Registered Land Surveyor, shows a 1" iron pipe with a 4" aluminum cap replaced from points of two rotted wood posts and more recent wood post. Blazed trees facing corner. WIT: 12" Cedar - N550E - 11.88'; 8" Cedar - S710W - 18.48'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Identified corner from existing 1" dia. Iron Pipe with a 4" dia. aluminum cap and 2 B.T.'s as described in L.C.R.C. No. 682 (see part "A") This corner has been accepted and used by local surveyors for 29 years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Accepted existing 1" Iron Pipe / 4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location:
