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

Witnesses to corrected corner Poplar 14 S25W 05 links and Poplar 10 N55W 23 links. Mr. Mullett in subdividing T36N,R24W on July 18,1848 set two additional witnesses: Cedar 6 N3E 05 links an Cedar 8 S22E 19 links.

Frank J. Bray, MDNR, May 15,1968 found a wood post and points of two rotted post which he replaced with a 1" iron pipe with a 4" aluminum cap. He also noted old blazes on trees facing and near corner. He made witnesses: W. Pine 8 S28E 17 links, W.Cedar 11 N65W 40 links, and W. Pine 8 S22W 20 links. Bray's report recc B.
