- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- J-9 No evidence of iron pin found. Corner position re-established by single proportion between the Southeast and Southwest corners of Section 23 using distances found in a description contained in the county road plans. Corner falls approximately 2 feet north of the centerline of the county road.
- K-9 No evidence of iron pin found. Corner position re-established by single proportion between found section corners one mile east and one mile west and in the centerline of the county road using distances found in a description contained in the county road plans. Corner falls approximately 1 foot east of old fencelines north and south.
- L-9 No evidence of iron pin found. Corner position re-established by single proportion between the Southeast and Southwest corners of Section 24 using distances found in a description contained in the county road plans. Distance checks fair to stream call west but it runs through a culvert under the road and may not be in the correct position.
