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I, <u>William Lenca</u>, in a field survey on <u>July</u>, 19<u>99</u> do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1852: Original Survey by Francis Coleman - B.T.'s - Cedar, 12" - N18°W - 31 lks; Cedar, 14" - S56°E - 34 lks. No original evidence for this corner was recovered.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

The double proportional position for this corner was computed and located. We searched the area and found no evidence of the original corner or subsequent restoration. The GLO Terrain calls to a stream 8.85 chains North and a marsh edge 2 chains West fit this location well. Distances to corners 1 mile West, 1 mile East, 1/2 mile North and 1/2 mile South compare favorably with GLO distances. We therefore accepted the double proportional location as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 3/4" dia. x 4' long aluminum rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner.
