

I. <u>William Lenca</u>, in a field survey on <u>July</u>, 19 99 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.



A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1852: Original Survey by Francis Coleman - B.T.'s -. Fir, 10" - N74°E - 96 lks.; Spruce, 10" - S82°W - 71 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by years of decay.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

The corner falls in a marshy area with a gravel roadway running through the area where the original corner would have stood. Fences running North - South - East and West would intersect in the center of the roadway. Using this position, we found that the measurements to corners 1/2 mile North and 1/2 mile South fit well. We therefore accepted the 4 way fence intersection as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner

Set 5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location:
