I, William Lenca, in a field survey on Sept. 10, 1998 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

- 1852: Original Survey by Francis Coleman - B.T.'s - Lynn, 12" - N38°W - 27 lks.; Hemlock, 12" - S71°E - 25 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.
1983: L.C.R.C. No. 578 by William Lenca, RLS 26461, states, "Set corner in line with centerline of county road east - west and in line with ancient fence to the north." Set Railroad Spike in Asphalt Surface. TIES: Anchor Pole (tack) - N05°W - 46.82'; Power Pole (tack) - S30°W - 40.70'; Deep-1 (gray) - S54°E - 45.58'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We found a railroad spike in a location as indicated in Land Corner Recordation Certificate Number 578. The centerline of a county road to the south is 6 feet East. This location has been used in previous surveys, fits well with other corners in the area, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
