

I, <u>William Lenca</u>, in a field survey on <u>July</u>, 19 <u>99</u> do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.



A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1852: Original Survey by Francis Coleman - B.T.'s - Beech, 8" - N47°W - 21 lks; Beech, 8" - S76°E - 34 lks. No original evidence for this corner was recovered.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

The South Quarter Corner of Section 16, T36N-R26W had been previously monumented. In retracing the South Line of Section 16 from this point West, we found a 4 way fence intersection which fit well with measurements to corners 1 mile West, 1/2 mile East and 1/2 mile North. This fence intersection is in an area of some large beech trees, but none of them match the original B.T.'s. We accepted the position of the old fence corner as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 2" dia. Aluminum Pipe 30" long/3-1/4" dia. Alum cap stamped for corner location:
