A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1852: Original Survey by Francis Coleman - B.T.'s - Tamarack, 6" - N43°W - 24 lks.; Cedar, 8" - S05°E - 25 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by County Road improvements.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

A concientious search of the most probable location for this corner produced no evidence of restoration, so the corner was re-set in the centerline of a North - South County Road, in line with the centerline of an old lane running East and with an ancient fence line running West. This location was accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location in Monument Box:
