- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We set this corner at the intersection of county road centerlines East - West, and North, and in line with an old fence to the South. This location matches existing lines of occupation, fits very well with measurements a half mile to the North and South, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
