- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - 1847: Original Survey by H. Floyd B.T.'s Birch, 8" N46^oE 31 lks.; Cedar, 20" N40^oW 40 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by County Road improvements.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We recovered a 5/8 inch \times 24 inch iron rod in the centerline of county roads North - East and West, 4 inches below the asphalt in the old road surface. This corner fits well with existing lines of occupation, has been used by local surveyors for several years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
