

 - 1980: Certified Survey No. 176 recorded by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, shows this corner as it relates to Corners J-13 (S1/4 Corner of Section 35, T36N-R27W) and Corner K-12 (E1/4 Corner of Section 35, T36N-R27W). No description of the corner monument is given, and no corner ties are shown.

In an August, 1995 survey of Section 1, T35N-R27W, we recovered a boat spike in the centerline of County Road No. 358 (East -West) and in line with a County Road running North. The position of the boat spike matches record measurments shown in Certified Survey No.'s 176 and 657 to existing corners 1/2 mile East, West, North and South This position has been used consistently for several years by local surveyors, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
