A. Description of original mo	onument and accessor	ries and/or subsequent restoration:	13:			

- 1847: Original Survey (Twp Bdy) by James H. Mullett B.T.'s Tamarack, 12" S85°W 23 lks.; Tamarack, 7" N67°W 17 lks. No original evidence was evident.
- 1852: Original Survey (Sec Subd) by George Adair B.T.'s Tamarack , 10" N66°W 14 lks.; Tamarack , 12" S44°E 25 lks. Original evidence was destroyed by farming activities.
- 1986: L.C.R.C. No. 744, recorded by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461, states: "Set corner on line and proportionately between Township Corners NW Corner Section 18 and SW Corner Section 19." Set 3/4" x 60" aluminum rod/3" dia. cap marked MENOMINEE COUNTY SURVEY MARKER B.T.'s: 6" Cedar S67°E 52.12' (found); 5" Ash S04°W 55.66' (found); 6" Black Spruce S63°W 17.11' (gone); 6" Cedar N20°W 23.32' (found).
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We found that the corner monument described in L.C.R.C. No. 744 (see part A) had been destroyed by road improvements, however, we recovered 3 of the B.T.'s described in L.C.R.C. No. 744, and replaced the corner from these witnesses. This position fits with a single proportional location between the NW Corner of Section 18 (A-7) and the Southwest Corner of Section 19 (A-9), and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Set 2" dia. Aluminum Pipe/3-1/4" dia. Alum cap stamped for corner location:
