B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We found a 1" dia. Iron Pipe/4" dia. Alum. cap and 2 Bearing Trees as described in part "A". The Spruce B.T. - N52°W - 7.5 lks was broken off. We also found the old wood stakes along side the corner monument, and remnants of the rotted stump bottoms to the NE and SW. Our measured distance West to the edge of swamp and foot of hill (572 feet) fits very well with the GLO call (8.5 chains or 561 feet). We accepted this location as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
