- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - Original Survey by James H. Mullett B.T.'s Sugar, 10" S45°W 14 lks.; Ironwood, 6" N53°W 22 lks. All original
 - evidence for this corner has been destroyed by farming activities. L.C.R.C. No. 816 by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461, states Fd 1" dia. I.P. at fence cor - position fits well with section corners N. & S. B.T.'s: 10" Elm - North - 10.29'; 10" Cherry - S85°E - 66.11'; 8" Elm - South - 73.42'. 1988:
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We recovered a 1 inch diameter iron pipe in line with ancient fence lines running North - South and East. We also found 3 B.T.'s as described in L.C.R.C. No. 816 above. This corner position fits very closely with a single proportional location, has been used for many years by local surveyors, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Set 3/4" dia. x 4' long aluminum rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner inside existing 1" dia. Iron Pipe
